

ORDINANCE NO. 87-01

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY LYING NORTH OF KEDRON
PIKE TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents and property
owners of the areas hereinafter described have petitioned the
Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that these
areas be annexed to its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen
of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of
Spring Hill and the territory hereinafter described which is
proposed to be annexed by the Ordinance will be materially
retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and
property thereof endangered unless this territory is annexed to
the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL that the following
described areas be annexed to and become a part of the corporate
limits of the Town of Spring Hill, to-wit:

The following described area on the North side of the
Kedron Pike which is East of and adjacent to the
present city limits:

1. Being all that portion of the Sallie Weaver Estate
property (Tax Map 43, Parcel 15) lying on the North
side of the Kedron Pike
2. That portion of the property of Naveen Scrinivas,
formerly W. J. Baker, (Tax Map 43, Parcel 12) which
lies North of the Kedron Pike
3. All of the property of Lucy Fann, formerly Aubrey
Baker et ux (Tax Map 50, Parcel 10)

4. The property of Mrs. Alma Elizabeth Glenn property (Tax Map 43, Parcel 13)
5. The property of Winnie Kincaid (Tax Map 50, Parcel 8)
6. The property of Hollis Williams and others lying on the East side of the Tom Lunn Road (Tax Map 50, Parcel 11.01)

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deem the annexation of the above described property to be necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the area annexed hereby as well as the municipality as a whole.

This Ordinance was passed on third reading after a public hearing was held on February 16, 1987, upon the question of this annexation after notice thereof was duly published in the Daily Herald of Columbia, Tennessee on February 2, 1987.

This Ordinance was further adopted after the adoption of a Plan of Services for a certain area proposed to be annexed in conformity with and as provided by Sec. 6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become operative thirty (30) days after the final passage thereof.


