
AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 82-4 WHICH EXEMPTED
FROM TAXATION ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY
USED FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:


WHEREAS, the State Board of Equalization has advised
the Town of Spring Hill and the Maury County Assessor of
Properties that the Board did not have the authority to exempt
agricultural property from ad valorem property taxation and has
instructed the Board that it must use as its tax roll that
received from the Maury County Assessor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that Ordinance 82-4 is
hereby repealed and Section 6-103 of the Spring Hill Municipal
Code is amended accordingly by deleting this Section.


