

ORDINANCE NO. 83-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO THE SALE OF BEER BY DELETING THE PORTION PROHIBITING THE SALE OF BEER ON ELECTION DAYS AND BY CHANGING THE LEGAL AGE FOR BEER SALES TO CONFORM TO STATE LAW

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

SECTION 1: That Subsection (3) of Section 2-212 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code be amended by deleting therefrom the words "or on election days before and while the polls are lawfully open." and by changing the semicolon (;) after the word Sunday to a period (.).

SECTION 2: That Subsections (2), (5) and (6) of Section 2-212 of said Municipal Code be amended by striking therefrom the words and figures "twenty-one (21) years of age" and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures "nineteen (19) years of age or such other age as may be prescribed now or hereafter by that portion of the Tennessee Code pertaining to possession of beer now set forth in Section 57-5-301 (e) of Tennessee Code Annotated."
