

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 79-9 of the Town of Spring Hill reimposed a sewer connection charge of \$100.00 for each connection made to the sanitary sewer system until June 3, 1980, and further provided that after that date the sewer connection charge would be an amount established by a vote of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen and the cost to the Town of Spring Hill of connecting each building to the sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have determined to fix the sewer service charge pursuant to said Ordinance at the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that from and after this date, until changed by a vote of said Board, the sewer connection charge will be the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each building connected to the sewer system and the cost to the Town of Spring Hill of each such connection.



of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee as follows:


Whereas a public hearing was held on May 19, 1980
