

RESOLUTION NO. 84-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF  
AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS  
FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF  
THE CITY PARK  
AND COMMITTING THE CITY TO MATCH FEDERAL  
FUNDS FOR SUCH DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee has developed a design concept for the development of the City Park as a major regional recreational facility; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Spring Hill, Tennessee supports the design concept and the proposal that this facility should be developed in accordance with the plan evolved from this concept; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Spring Hill, Tennessee is confident that an effective city-state-federal-volunteer program can be developed to implement this plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE.

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be authorized to file a 1984 pre-application with the Tennessee Department of Conservation for a \$12,000.00 grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Program to be used for the development of

SECTION 2. That the Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby expresses its intent to provide funds of up to \$\_\_\_\_\_ on a fifty percent matching basis, against a Land And Water Conservation Fund grant for this purpose.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring same.
