

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation proposes to construct a relocation of U. S. Highway 31 around the central portion of the Town of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, there have been two routes proposed for this By-Pass, one lying East and the other West of the present location of U. S. Highway 31; and


WHEREAS, The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill have considered the routes proposed and have reached a determination that the proposed Eastern route which would extend from the Saturn Parkway - Kedron Road interchange Northwardly to the North city limits is to the best interests of the inhabitants of the Town of Spring Hill and those persons living within the general area of the proposed relocation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, that it supports and endorses this route and urges the construction of the Spring Hill By-Pass at this location.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Lamar Alexander, Governor of the State of Tennessee, and the Honorable Dale Kelley, Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Transportation.

ary, 1986.


