

RESOLUTION 86-17

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation proposes to remark Main Street (U. S. Highway 31, State Route 6) in the Town of Spring Hill to provide for three lanes of traffic including one lane in each direction and a middle two-way left turn lane; and

WHEREAS, this Department has advised the Board of Mayor and Aldermen that it will be necessary to prohibit curb parking on both sides of Main Street from a point approximately 600 feet North of Lake Avenue to a point approximately 600 feet North of Duplex Road and has requested a Resolution be passed prohibiting this curb parking; and

WHEREAS, Section 9-504(11) of the Spring Hill Municipal Code prohibits parking along any curb painted yellow or red in the Town of Spring Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill;

1. That parking is hereby prohibited on both sides of Main Street (U. S. Highway 31, State Route 6) within the Town of Spring Hill from a point approximately 600 feet North of its intersection with Lake Avenue (sometimes referred to as Kedron Road) to a point approximately 600 feet North of its intersection with Duplex Road; and

2. That the curbs along Main Street be painted to reflect no parking, either yellow or red, by the Tennessee Department of Transportation or the Town of Spring Hill as may be

agreed between them and no parking signs be erected along those portions of Main Street (U. S. Highway 31, State Route 6) where there are no curbs at the present time.


