

RESOLUTION NO. 87-14

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

That the Maury County Election Commission is hereby requested, pursuant to Section 6-1-301 of Tennessee Code Annotated, to hold an election within the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill on the question of whether or not to adopt a charter set forth in Chapters 1, 2, and 51 through 57 of Title 6 and Chapters 31 through 37, 51, 52, 54, and 61 through 63 of Title 7 of Tennessee Code Annotated. If adopted, the Town would be divided into the same four wards as it is presently divided, the First Ward to be all of the territory south of McLemore Street and an eastwardly extension thereof and East of Main Street; the Second Ward to consist of all the territory north of McLemore Street and an extension thereof and east of Main Street; the Third Ward to consist of all of the territory north of Depot Street and Sugar Ridge Road and west of Main Street and the Fourth Ward to consist of all the territory south of Depot Street and Sugar Ridge Road and west of Main Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election be held not less than forty-five (45) nor more than sixty (60) days from the receipt of a certified copy of this Resolution by the Maury County Election Commission as provided in Section 2-3-204 and that the ballot be that as prescribed by Section 6-1-301 of the Code.


