RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on the 18th day of May, 1987, unanimously adopted Resolution Number 87-14 by which the Maury County Election Commission was requested to hold an election within the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill on the question of whether or not to adopt a Charter as provided in Section 6-1-301 of Tennessee Code Annotated; and

WHEREAS, as a result thereof the Maury County Election Commission scheduled and held an election on this question on the 25th day of July, 1987, at which time a majority of the voters voting in the election voted to adopt such Charter, the results of this election as certified by the Election Commission being as

follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing result of this election be spread upon the records of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill and a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the Secretary of State as provided in Section 6-1-302 of Tennessee Code Annotated.



We, the undersigned Commissioners of Elections of Maury County, Tenn. do hereby certify that on the 25th day of July, 1987 pursuant to notices properly given in newspapers published in Maury County, a special election was held at the Spring Hill High School precinct between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the following:
