

RESOLUTION NUMBER 87-21

RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE FIRST OCTOBER 1987 PLAN OF SERVICES
FOR CERTAIN PROPERTIES LYING IN WILLIAMSON AND MAURY COUNTIES
AND SUBMITTING IT TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents and all of the
property owners of the areas hereinafter described have
petitioned the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring
Hill that these areas be annexed to its corporate limits; and


WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen
of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of
Spring Hill and certain areas lying in Williamson and Maury
Counties will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare
of the inhabitants and property endangered unless the areas are
annexed to the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill and
that such annexation is necessary for the welfare of the
residents and the property owners of the proposed territories as
well as the Town of Spring Hill as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, as provided in 6-51-102(b) of Tennessee
Code Annotated, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby proposes
the annexation of the properties set forth in the attached First
October 1987 Plan of Services which is hereby made a part of this
resolution.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plan of Services set

Regional Planning Commission for study and written report to this Board within ninety (90) days from this date.


