
R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting on November 16, 1987, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill submitted to the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission a proposed First November 1987 Plan of Services for certain territories lying in Maury County under consideration for annexation; and

WHEREAS, the annexation statutes of the State of Tennessee require a public hearing on the proposed Plan of Services and annexation prior to its adoption by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that a public hearing be held on the proposed First November 1987 Plan of Services at 6:50 p.m. on Monday, December 14, 1987, and on the proposed annexation at 6:55 p.m., on Monday, December 21, 1987. The Recorder and City Attorney are hereby instructed to give notice of these meetings as required by law.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 16th day of November, 1987.





FIRST NOVEMBER 1987 ~~AMENDED~~ PLAN OF SERVICES FOR AREAS UNDER
CONSIDERATION FOR ANNEXATION TO THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill proposes the following Plan of Services for certain areas on the North and South sides of the Kedron Pike under consideration for annexation:

1. Police and fire protection will be provided immediately upon the effective date of annexation.
2. Water service is provided to the areas by a public water system which will continue upon its annexation.
3. Electrical service is currently provided to the areas proposed to be annexed.
4. A sanitary sewage system will be extended to the Weaver property within ten (10) years from the effective date of annexation except for any areas which might prove economically not feasible to serve.
5. Solid waste disposal to residents of the areas comparable to that currently afforded residents of Spring Hill would be provided commencing January 1, 1988.
6. Road and street construction and repair:
All roads within the areas are maintained by Maury County and will either continue to be maintained by the County or be maintained by Spring Hill.
7. Recreational facilities:
The recreational facilities located within the Town of Spring Hill will be available to the inhabitants of the annexed areas immediately upon the effective date of annexation.

8. Zoning services:

The areas under consideration for annexation would be zoned immediately upon annexation or as soon thereafter as this could reasonably be accomplished.

The areas proposed to be annexed are the following described areas which are adjacent to the present city limits:

1. All of the Sallie Weaver Estate property, Tax Map 43, Parcel 15, lying on the South side of Kedron Pike.
2. The Town of Spring Hill Sewer Treatment Plant property, Tax Map 43, Parcel 5.01.

This Plan of Services was approved by a Resolution adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill at a meeting held on the 16th day of November, 1987.
