

RESOLUTION NO. 95-19

A RESOLUTION TO FUND THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF CHLORINATION IMPROVEMENTS  
TO THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

Whereas, the growth in wastewater volume flowing through and being treated by the Spring Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant has increased to the extent that the original chlorination treatment system is overloaded and is now inadequate;

Whereas, The Division of Water Pollution Control of the Tennessee Division of Environment and Conservation has required of the Town of Spring Hill a better quality of sewage treatment in order to rid discharged effluent of health endangering pathogens;

Whereas, the Town received bids on December 14, 1995, for construction of chlorination improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Plant, but the bids were high or unresponsive and were accordingly rejected in favor of the Town completing the project by having the wastewater superintendent act as construction manager with the advice and assistance of the Town's consulting engineer, Water Management Systems of Nashville;

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE** that the Town shall fund the construction of chlorination improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Plant with a sum of \$18,000 drawn from the "Sewer Reserve Capital Expansion" fund, with construction management of the project to be done by the wastewater superintendent with the advice and assistance of the Town's consulting engineer, Water Management Systems of Nashville, the public welfare requiring same.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 18th day of December, 1995.
