

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY
TO THE SPRING HILL FIRE CHIEF AND POLICE CHIEF
TO NEGOTIATE PROPOSED MUTUAL AID AGREEMENTS
BETWEEN THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL AND ADJACENT AGENCIES**

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Town of Spring Hill to enter into mutual aid agreements, pursuant to 6-54-307, et seq., and Part 6 of Chapter 54 of Title 6, Tennessee Code Annotated, with adjacent agencies in order to augment the limited resources of Spring Hill in crisis situations involving both fire and law enforcement incidents; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the participating agencies to appoint as negotiating representatives, the most affected members of agency staff; these being acknowledged to be the fire chief and police chief in their respective departmental functions; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that adjacent agencies will pass resolutions to match, in content, this resolution;

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED:

1. The police and fire chiefs are hereby granted full authority and responsibility to negotiate mutual aid agreements on behalf of Spring Hill.

2. No monies will be owed by one agency to another as a contract condition.

3. Any risk and liability will be carried by the responding agencies for incidents located outside their agency boundaries.

4. No such agreement will be signed in behalf of Spring Hill until signed in its behalf by the Mayor and City Administrator.




