
A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE IN SUCH A WAY AS TO ALLOW A SIXTY (60) SQUARE FOOT SIGN ON THE PROPERTY WHERE THE SPRING HILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IS LOCATED ON MAIN STREET AND FURTHER REQUESTING THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO CONDUCT A STUDY AND RECOMMEND SUCH OTHER CHANGES AS IT DEEMS APPROPRIATE FOR SIGN PROVISIONS IN THE ZONING ORDINANCE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

1. That the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission is hereby requested to amend the Zoning Ordinance so as to allow the erection and maintenance of a sign containing sixty (60) square feet on the property where the Spring Hill Elementary School is located, such sign to be erected and maintained by the Spring Hill Elementary School Parents/Teachers Organization.

2. The Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission is hereby further requested to conduct a study of all of the sign provisions of the Zoning Ordinance and to make a recommendation to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen either for certain amendments to these provisions or a separate sign ordinance prescribing rules and regulations for the erection and maintenance of signs within the Town of Spring Hill or a combination of both.


