

**RESOLUTION 99-37**


**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A BILL IN THE  
TENNESSEE STATE LEGISLATURE TO CHANGE THE ELECTED TERM OF THE  
MAYOR TO A FOUR (4) YEAR TERM**

**WHEREAS**, the current length of time the Mayor is elected to serve is two  
(2) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor's term of office needs to correspond to the length of  
terms for the Board of Aldermen which is four (4) years

**NOW, THEREFORE** Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen  
of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City Attorney is authorized to  
prepare and file any and all documents necessary to change the term of office of  
the Mayor to a four (4) year term beginning with the next election in April, 2001.
