COMMUNITY BUILDING**


**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Community Building is increasingly being used by people other than Spring Hill residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the wear and tear on the building is not adequately covered by rental fees and the outside bookings often prevent use by Spring Hill residents


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the rental and use of the Spring Hill Community Building be restricted to the residents and businesses within the city limits of Spring Hill.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this restriction shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
