

## **RESOLUTION 99-50**

### **A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A PLAN OF SERVICES FOR AN AREA TO BE ANNEXED AS DESCRIBED HEREAFTER, AND ALSO DESCRIBED IN ORDINANCE 99-42**

The Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, proposes the following Plan of Services for the following area of annexation;


All of the property bounded on the East side by the Eastern right-of-way of Interstate 65 from a point of intersection with Thompson Station Road on the North to a point of intersection with Duplex Road on the South; and bounded by the existing city limits on the South side; and bounded by the Western right-of-way of Buckner Lane on the West side; consisting of seventeen hundred (1700) acres, more or less; and the following parcels of land as shown on the Williamson County Tax Maps; to wit: Tax Map 166, Parcel 2, Tax Map 166, Parcel 3, Parcel 3.01, Tax Map 166, Parcel 58, Parcel 58.01, Tax Map 166, Parcel 59, Tax Map 166, Parcel 13, Tax Map 166, Parcel 13.01, Parcel 13.02, Tax Map 154, Parcel 59.02, Parcel 64, Parcel 65.01 , total Parcels consisting of 171.93 acres, more or less.

1. Police protection: Police protection will be provided immediately upon the effective date of annexation.
2. Fire protection: Fire protection will be provided immediately upon the effective date of the annexation.
3. Solid waste disposal: Solid waste collection and disposal service will be provided immediately upon the effective date of the annexation.
4. Road and street construction and maintenance: Will be provided immediately upon the effective date of the annexation.
5. Recreation facilities and programs: All recreational facilities and programs will be available to the area immediately upon the effective date of the annexation.
6. Planning and zoning services: Planning and zoning services will be provided to the area immediately upon the effective date of the annexation.
7. Street lights: Street lights will be installed in the area within one (1) year after the effective date of the annexation.

8. Water service: Municipal water service will be provided to the area within two (2) years after the effective date of the annexation.
9. Sewer service: Municipal sanitary sewer service will be provided to the area within three (3) years after the effective date of the annexation.
10. All other services of the Town: All other services offered by the Town will be made available to the area immediately upon the effective date of the annexation.

This Plan of Services was presented to the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission for study and was reviewed by the Planning Commission and recommended for approval on December 13, 1999, and was published in the The Daily Herald on December 30, 1999, the Franklin Review Appeal on December 30, 1999, and The Tennessean, Williamson County A.M. on December 30, 1999.
