A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY
ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONDUCT AN ELECTION
WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL ON APRIL 8, 1999,
TO ELECT A MAYOR AND ONE ALDERMAN
FOR EACH OF THE FOUR WARDS PURSUANT
TO THE ELECTION LAWS OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF
SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

1. The Maury County Election Commission be authorized and requested to conduct the regular municipal election for the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on Thursday, April 8, 1999, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Alderman from each of the four wards, all from the Town at large, each for a term of four years with the exception of the Mayor who shall serve for a term of two years. The Commission is requested to publish notice of the election in Maury County and Williamson County.

2. Early voting shall include the following Saturdays: March 20, March 27 and April 3, 1999. To facilitate a better turnout, the Maury County election Commission is requested to hold early voting at Spring Hill Town Hall, with the Town bearing the extra cost of a dedicated telephone line.


3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to request the Maury County Election Commission to hold the April 8, 1999, election, the cost of which will, by law, be borne by the Town of Spring Hill.
