A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL CENSUS  
OF THE CITIZENS  
OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE


Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill has conducted a special State of Tennessee census in 1995 and 1996 for the purpose of gaining rightful share of State shared taxes, and

Whereas, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen have determined, based upon building permits sold since May, 1996, that population has increased significantly, and

Whereas, the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee has authorized a maximum of three (3) special census counts between federal decennial census taking for the purpose of assistance to fast growth towns such as Spring Hill;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that a special city wide census be conducted in accordance with "Procedures for Taking Special Census in Population Certification" established by the Local Planning Assistance Office (LPAO) of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development, with the results to be presented to the LPAO for certification.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 17th day of February, 1998.


