

RESOLUTION No. 98-46

A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE RESIDENTIAL RATE  
FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION  
FROM \$8.25 PER MONTH TO \$8.50  
IN ORDER TO COMPENSATE FOR A RISE IN VENDOR RATES

Whereas, the vendor for garbage collection and disposal services, USA Waste (formerly Sanifill) has increased the rate for residential collection by a 2% CPI increase, and

Whereas, the governing Board has determined that a consequent increase in the rate charged by the Town for garbage collection is justified, and

Whereas, Ordinance 88-05, the defining garbage ordinance for the Town of Spring Hill, paragraph 12.01, stipulates that fees for garbage collection shall be set by Resolution of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen, and

Whereas, the increase stipulated herein is incremental and very limited in it's annual impact upon the customers


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the billing clerks of the Town are authorized to increase the residential garbage rate from \$8.25 to \$8.50 per month per household and to have this increase advertised, published and put into effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 20th day of July, 1998.




