WITH JIM YORK DBA ETA COMPANY, COLUMBIA, TENNESSEE,
IN ORDER TO HAVE SUCH WORK DONE BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT
IN THE INTEREST OF BUDGET ECONOMY


Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill entered into a one year contract for the privatization of meter reading services on July 1, 1996, such contract to be extended indefinitely by mutual consent of the parties, and

Whereas, the Town has entered into new technology with automated meter readers thereby lowering the man hours required to read meters and further, that cost analysis indicates it would now behoove the water department to commence the meter reading service with an in-house operation, and

Whereas, the contract conditions include a 90 day condition for termination by either party and the governing Board has decided to exercise the option of termination


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the city administrator is authorized, empowered and directed to send a certified letter to the contractor, Jim York dba ETA Company, P.O. Box 323, Columbia, Tennessee, advising him that the meter reading contract will be terminated 90 days from the date of such letter.
