

**A RESOLUTION TO ACKNOWLEDGE THAT
THE GOVERNING BODY OF SPRING HILL
HAS REVIEWED THE TENNESSEE WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION SURVEY
(TWPPS) AND IS TAKING ACTION
TO REMEDY PROBLEMS AS SHOWN IN THE REPORT
AS PREPARED BY THE SPRING HILL WASTE WATER SUPERINTENDENT**

Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill has participated in the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Construction Grants and Loans, TWPPS waste water plant report, and

Whereas, the Spring Hill waste water superintendent has compiled historical data and had such data reviewed and approved by the WWTP consulting engineer for the Town, Water Management Services, and

Whereas, the Town is preparing to invest heavily in improvements to the sewer system

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill, that the TWPPS, as prepared by the Spring Hill waste water superintendent, is acknowledged and accepted, and further that the governing Board will stipulate that numerous improvements are to be made in the waste water system; these improvements are to include the following:

1. Increased oxygen supply will be added to the WW lagoons as aspirating aerators are replaced by radial aerators.
2. Elimination of most of the force main effluent will be effected as gravity collection lines are constructed, all of which are in the survey, design or construction phase at date of adoption of this resolution.
3. A new 2 mgd waste water plant is presently in the design phase, scheduled for bid in mid-1998, with construction to be completed between July and December, 1999.
4. A purchase of a jet washer for cleansing of sewer lines is in the FY 1998 budget but purchase has been delayed due to inability to hire a technically competent supervisor; such jet washing maintenance program will be initiated in FY 1999.
