A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT  
WITH TRAFMARK FOR TRAFFIC MARKINGS SUFFICIENT TO ALTER THE  
INTERSECTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY 31 AND KEDRON ROAD  
TO INSURE SAFETY FOR THE SUM OF \$2,875,  
FUNDS ARE TO BE DRAWN  
FROM STREET DEPARTMENT CAPITOL OUTLAY FUNDS FOR FY 98


Whereas, safety at the intersection of U.S. Highway 31 and Kedron Road is a constant problem due to the merging of two north bound lanes into one lane at the traffic signal, and

Whereas, staff determined the most safety oriented solution to this problem, while in contemplation of economy, is to restrict the inside north bound lane to left turns only while the outside north bound lane is right turn and through lane only, and to change traffic signals and street markings and signage to so indicate, and

Whereas, specifications for this work were publicly advertised, bids were taken, and TrafMark, Franklin, Tennessee, was determined to be the lowest and best bidder


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with TrafMark to have road surface work done to insure lane use as specified for the sum of \$2,875 with funds to be drawn for FY 98 street department capitol funds

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 20th day of April, 1998.


