**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH
"THE SIGN MEN", SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS,
TO PURCHASE TRAFFIC SIGNS AND POSTS FOR PURPOSE
OF UPGRADING SIGNS ON ARTERIALS AND LOCAL STREETS
IN SPRING HILL, FOR A COMBINED SUM NOT
TO EXCEED THE SUM OF \$15,000, WITH FUNDS IN
AMOUNT OF \$10,000 TO BE DRAWN FROM
THE GOVERNORS HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT AND
FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 TO BE DRAWN
FROM FUND BALANCE IN IMPACT FEES
FUNDS ARE TO BE DRAWN
FROM THE STATE STREET AID FUND
FOR FY 98 AND FROM
THE GOVERNORS HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAM (\$10,000 GRANT)**

**Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill applied for and received a
\$10,000 grant, for traffic sign improvements on local streets,
from the Governors Highway Safety Program, and**

**Whereas, the governing Board reviewed and revised speed limits on
State routes arterials, and**

**Whereas, recurring complaints against poor signage have been
brought before the city judge in traffic court resulting in
dismissal of citations, and**

**Whereas, bid requests were publicly advertised and bids were
received from the three vendors**

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of
the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are
authorized, empowered and directed to enter into agreement with
The Sign Men, San Antonio, Texas, per unit prices as shown in
their bid response, in a sum not to exceed a total of \$ 15,000
with funds to be reimbursed from the Governors Highway Safety
Grant in the amount of \$10,000 and funds in the amount of \$5,000
to be drawn from fund balance impact fees**
