A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF SPRING HILL  
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH  
WOODALL EXCAVATING AND GRADING, HOHENWALD, TENNESSEE,  
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A GRAVITY SEWER LINE  
NAMED "AUGUSTA PLACE CONNECTOR" AND  
FOR PREPARATION FOR A NEW LIFT STATION LOCATION  
AND RELOCATION OF THE EXISTING WYNGATE PUMP  
TO THIS NEW LOCATION WITH MONIES IN THE AMOUNT \$47,322.00  
TO BE DRAWN FROM SEWER RESERVE CAPACITY FEES


Whereas, it is necessary to construct a sewer gravity connector from Augusta Place subdivision to the existing pump station location in Wyngate subdivision in order to have gravity flow of Wyngate subdivision sewage, and

Whereas, plans were prepared by Highers Koonce and Associates, consulting engineers, thence the project was publicly advertised and bids were received on July 16, 1998, and Wodall Excavating and Grading, Hohenwald, Tennessee, was determined to be the lowest and best bid, and

Whereas, for multiple reasons, time is of the essence in completion of this project


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with Wodall Excavating and Grading to have the Augusta Place Connector constructed and further to have a new lift station site prepared and to have the existing Wyngate lift pumps relocated to the new lift station site with funding in the amount of \$47,322.00 with funds to be drawn from sewer reserve capacity fees.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 20th day of July, 1998.


