

RESOLUTION No. 98-58

A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE TWO GOLDEN EAGLE RADAR UNITS
FOR POLICE CRUISERS FROM KUSTOM SIGNALS, INC.,
FOR THE SUM OF \$6,028.00, THE STATE BID,
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM CAPITOL OUTLAY FUNDS
OF THE FY 1999 POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET
AS SET ASIDE FOR THAT PURPOSE

Whereas, the police department is in need for two additional radar units: one radar to be placed in a police cruiser which is the former detective cruiser that has no radar, and one to replace a radar in a cruiser which had a MPH (brand name) radar; this latter radar has lost sensitivity thereby rendering it useless as a law enforcement tool (speed recorded is accurate but won't record at times), and

Whereas, a request for bids was publicly advertised, bids were received, and Kustom Signals, Inc., was found to be the only bidder, and

Whereas, Kustom Signals, Inc., also held their price at the same figure as one year ago on bids which was the State of Tennessee purchase bids for radars

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the police department is authorized to purchase two Golden Eagle Radars from Kustom Signals, Inc., for the sum of \$6,028.00 with funds to be drawn from capitol outlay funds of the FY 1999 police department budget.
