A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT  
WITH FLOYD AND FLOYD, COLUMBIA, TN, FOR RECONSTRUCTION  
OF A PART OF BUCKNER ROAD EXTENDING  
FROM BUCKNER PLACE TO DEPARTURE FROM OLD BUCKNER ROAD  
OF THE NEW ROUTE TO U.S. 31  
FOR THE SUM OF \$353,690.00 WITH FUNDS  
TO BE DRAWN FROM ACCUMULATED IMPACT FEES

Whereas, Buckner Road reconstruction has been deemed as necessary by the governing Board because of Heritage Elementary School and the for relief from a dangerous intersection on U.S. 31 as well as relief from poor vertical and horizontal sight distances and bad geometry on the existing road, and

Whereas, arrangements have previously been made for participation in this project by a developer for the grade and base work for the new part of Buckner Road and by Williamson County for the paving of all of the reconstruction, and

Whereas, request for bids was publicly advertised, bids were received and Floyd and Floyd, Columbia, Tennessee, was determined to be the lowest and best bidder

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into agreement with Floyd and Floyd, Columbia, Tennessee, for the reconstruction of Old Buckner Road from the edge of Buckner Place subdivision to the point where new road construction will depart from Old Buckner Road for the sum of \$353,970.00 with funds to be drawn from accumulated impact fees.
