A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH
OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES IN MAURY COUNTY TO INCLUDE
CITY OF COLUMBIA
CITY OF MOUNT PLEASANT
MAURY COUNTY GOVERNMENT
MAURY COUNTY SHERIFF
(OR SUCH AGENCIES AS LISTED ADOPTING THE AGREEMENT)
TO RENDER MUTUAL AID AND ASSISTANCE
BETWEEN VARIOUS AGENCY DEPARTMENTS

Whereas, there is a need to maintain the umbrella of insurance coverage as well as the statutory limits on tort liability for local government, and

Whereas, department heads from the agencies in Maury County have reviewed the proposed umbrella mutual aid agreement and have come to mutual acceptance of a recommendation to the respective governing Boards to adopt, and

Whereas, the City of Columbia has adopted this mutual aid agreement and it is anticipated that other agencies will take action to adopt

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the City of Columbia, City of Mount Pleasant, Maury County and the Maury County Sheriff to have the various departments of government render aid and assistance to other signatory agencies included in this agreement per the conditions of the agreement
