

RESOLUTION 17-96

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES WITH ARCHITECTS DESIGN GROUP/ADA, INC. FOR THE POLICE HEADQUARTERS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor of Mayor and Alderman approved as part of the FY17-18 Capital Improvement Plan for the City of Spring Hill the funding for professional design services to prepare design plans and related bid documentation for the new police headquarters project; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Resolution 17-96 presented by City staff to select Architects Design Group/ADA, Inc. to provide professional design services for the new police headquarters project; and

WHEREAS, Architects Design Group/ADA, Inc. has prepared for consideration and execution by the City of Spring Hill an AIA Document B101-2007, Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Architect, along with Exhibits A through E that reflect the desired scope of work and associated design fee for Phase 1-A, 1-B, 1-C, and 1-D for the new police headquarters project proposed to be constructed within the Northfield Building; and

WHEREAS, Architects Design Group/ADA, Inc. in consideration of the professional design services contained in the AIA Document B101-2007, Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Architect, and Exhibit D, as revised, the compensation to perform said professional design services shall be a fixed fee in the amount of \$94,260, inclusive of reimbursable expenses, attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill authorizes the Mayor of the City of Spring Hill, TN to sign the AIA Document B101-2007, Standard Form of Agreement Between Owner and Architect, that includes Exhibits A through E, the compensation of which to perform said professional design services shall be fixed fee in the amount of \$94,260, inclusive of reimbursable expenses, hereto attached.


