

RESOLUTION NO. 96-72

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS
TO UPGRADE MAIN STREET WATER LINE**

Whereas, there exists a section of water line along the west side of Main Street which serves a minimum of six (6) businesses, and the line is giving recurring break and repair problems ;


Whereas, this forty to fifty year old line is a combination of one inch and 2.5 inch line sizes in diameter and inside accretion is further constricting the line size, and the age and size of the line is inadequate for efficient service of a commercial district;

Whereas, it is in the interest of the Town to remedy a portion of these water system age and size problems on a yearly basis to keep the system problems from accumulating into a future crisis program; and

Whereas, it is determined that the most cost effective means to perform this work is by in-house construction with the assistance of the Tennessee Department of Corrections inmate crew.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the expenditure of the sum of \$10,000.00 is approved with such funds to be taken from the annual operating budget of the water system, in order to upgrade a portion of the Main Street water service along the west side of Main Street in the vicinity of the Poplar House Restaurant and the future medical clinic.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 18th day of November, 1996.




