

RESOLUTION NO. 96-61

**A RESOLUTION TO SEEK A GRANT FOR THE MANAGEMENT
OF WASTE OIL IN SPRING HILL FROM THE DIVISION OF
SOLID WASTE ASSISTANCE OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE**

Whereas, there is currently no provision in a recycling program for the use of private persons to dispose of their used oil in an environmentally safe manner;


Whereas, it is in the public interest to provide a means of managing and safely disposing of oil and a local business has offered to be the disposal point; and

Whereas, the State of Tennessee has captured a disposal fee from all oil changes to fund such programs and money is available on a 100% grant basis.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the following resolution of intent is adopted:

A grant application will be prepared by Town employees and submitted to the Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Solid Waste Assistance, for funding assistance in collecting, hauling, and using waste oil for the benefit of citizens of Spring Hill.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 16th day of September, 1996.




