

RESOLUTION NO. 96-68

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE
CITY ADMINISTRATOR AS THE MUNICIPAL
HEALTH OFFICER OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE**

Whereas, the Spring Hill Municipal Code contains references to a municipal health officer, and it appears that no one has been designated to serve in that office;

Whereas, the provisions of the Municipal Code requiring or authorizing action by the municipal health officer cannot be carried out without a person designated to hold that office; and

Whereas, it does not appear that specific qualifications for a municipal health officer have been established by legislation or regulation of the State of Tennessee.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the person holding the office of City Administrator of the Town of Spring Hill shall hereby be deemed to be the municipal health officer of the Town of Spring Hill for all purposes set forth in the Spring Hill Municipal Code or otherwise by law.
