

RESOLUTION NO. 96-31


Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee has the authority to appropriate funds for the financial aid of any non-profit charitable organization or any non-profit civic organization in accordance with Section 6-54-111, Tennessee Code Annotated, and guidelines issued by the State of Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury; and

Whereas, the HOPE House, a non-profit charitable organization, has requested a direct appropriation for financial aid that will be used to promote the general welfare of the residents of the Town of Spring Hill.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:


The Town of Spring Hill is hereby authorized to pay to the HOPE House the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be included within the annual budget ordinance in accordance with authorizing provisions. It is understood that the funds contributed by the Town will be used to promote the general welfare of the residents of the Town of Spring Hill.
