**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATIONS TOWARD AN AGREEMENT  
WITH VARIOUS DEVELOPERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PORTION OF  
THE GRASSY BRANCH SEWER INTERCEPTOR IN THE VICINITY  
OF DUPLEX AND PORT ROYAL ROADS**

**Whereas**, several developers are currently planning developments along Duplex Road;

**Whereas**, these developers would typically construct their own sewer systems with pumps; and

**Whereas**, it is in the interest of the Town of Spring Hill to reduce the number of sewer pumps and to have constructed a necessary interceptor system that will eventually be constructed all the way to the Town's sewer treatment facility.


**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF  
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE** that:

Negotiations are authorized between the Town and various developers toward an agreement on construction of a portion of the proposed Grassy Branch sewer interceptor project as a common use instead of having each developer build its own system with separate pumps for each development.


