**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE FUNDING OF
LUMBER AND ASSOCIATED BUILDING SUPPLIES
FROM THE PARKS AND RECREATION BUDGET FOR
FISCAL YEAR 1996-97 IN ORDER FOR UNITED AUTO WORKERS
LOCAL 1853 TO CONTRIBUTE LABOR TOWARD
CONSTRUCTION OF A SMALL CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND**

Whereas, the United Auto Workers (UAW) Local 1853 has volunteered to construct a small children's playground if materials are made available;

Whereas, the Town is lacking such a facility and needs to have one according to the high ranking this need/want occupied on a 1995 public opinion survey conducted by the Town.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

Funding up to \$8,000.00 out of the fiscal year 1996-97 parks and recreation budget may be used at the discretion of the person or persons assigned the responsibility of coordinating for the Town the volunteer effort by UAW Local 1853 in its work in constructing a small children's playground in the Spring Hill Beechcroft park facility.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 19th day of August, 1996.




