**A RESOLUTION TO UPGRADE THE COURTROOM
SOUND SYSTEM AND AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE
SUM OF \$4,088.00 TO SOUTHEASTERN SOUND, INC.,
NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE, FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO
ACCOMMODATE ADDITIONAL NEEDED SPEAKERS,
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM THE GENERAL
OPERATING FUND OF THE TOWN**


Whereas, the sound system of Town Hall has become a recurring problem resulting in inadequate recording of comments from both the Board members and members of the public;

Whereas, this deficiency in audio recording has resulted in a loss of audio considered to be valuable to the Town in future negotiation and pre-trial and trial litigation proceedings; and

Whereas, Southeastern Sound, Inc., was the original vendor and is now considered by the Town to be the most cost effective and most qualified vendor of such services as described in this resolution.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that a contract be awarded to Southeastern Sound, Inc., of Nashville, Tennessee to perform additional work to improve the sound system in the courtroom of Town Hall, work to be done for the sum of \$4,088.00, with funds to be drawn from the Town's general operating fund.
