**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF BIDS
FOR THE DEMOLITION OF THE OLD WATER PUMP HOUSE
LOCATED ON MCLEMORE STREET**


Whereas, there has arisen an opportunity to have a derelict and now useless Town-owned structure on McLemore Street demolished at an economy price;

Whereas, this work must be done in order to later place the old McLemore fire hall on the market for sale at a just and reasonable price;

Whereas, this work is justified as expedient so as not to pay a greater sum of money at a later date for this same work.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the Board authorizes the public bidding of a contract for the demolition and removal of the old water pump station on McLemore Street so that the area can be made part of the parking lot until further use is found for the space. A report on the bids received shall be made to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. The Board shall decide whether to award a contract.
