

RESOLUTION NO. 97-17

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTINUING CONTRACT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT, INC. FOR ROLL-OFF RECYCLING BINS FOR PUBLIC USE FOR THE APPROXIMATE SUM OF \$220 PER MONTH, FUNDS TO BE TAKEN FROM THE SANITATION FUND

Whereas, Waste Management, Inc. (WMI) has determined that they can no longer provide roll-off recycling bins for public use free of charge due to the variable nature of the recyclables sales market;

Whereas, there has been some public demand for this service since no other recycling service is offered to the public within the boundaries of Spring Hill or nearby locations; and

Whereas, WMI has offered the most economical service of two vendors willing to perform this kind of recycling service and will continue to be the most logical recycling service vendor since WMI contracts to operate the Williamson County Recyclery on the south side of Franklin.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

1. The Town will continue on a six-month trial period the recycling service offered by Waste Management, Inc. at an approximate cost of \$220 per month (two roll-offs), with cost adjustments authorized since the cost of this service is affected by the recyclables sales market;
2. The City Administrator is authorized to negotiate adjustments to the contract within a 10% range of the aforementioned monthly cost;

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 17th day of March, 1997.




