**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HIGHERS, KOONCE AND ASSOCIATES,  
CONSULTING ENGINEERS, TO PREPARE WORKING DRAWINGS FOR  
IMPROVEMENTS TO THE KEDRON ROAD AND ROUTE 31 INTERSECTION  
WITH FUNDING TO BE DRAWN FROM IMPACT FEES IN ALL WARDS  
FOR A CONSULTING FEE BASED UPON FARMERS HOME ADMINISTRATION  
RECOMMENDED FEE SCHEDULE**


**Whereas**, the impending construction of traffic signalization at the intersection of Kedron Road and Route 31 will require a left turn or "stack" lane be constructed in east Kedron Road;

**Whereas**, Highers, Koonce and Associates, as consulting engineers to the Town, have already had preliminary survey work done to establish location of the traffic signal posts;


**Whereas**, this project will require early bidding so that traffic flow will work properly with the new traffic signal;

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE** that Highers, Koonce and Associates, consulting engineers, be authorized to proceed with the working drawings on improvements to the intersection at Kedron Road and Route 31, for a fee based upon the Farmers Home Administration recommended percentage schedule as based upon the bid project cost (a copy of the FHA schedule is attached), and further that the engineers have all work prepared for immediate public bid notice when the governing Board shall decide to proceed with construction funding.
