

RESOLUTION NO. 97-37

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE AND MAINLINE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR A 1,240 FT. EXTENSION OF THE GRASSY BRANCH INTERCEPTOR FOR THE SUM OF \$38,000 WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM SEWER RESERVE CAPACITY FEES

Whereas, there now exists an opportunity to add to the original length of the Grassy Branch Interceptor an additional 1,240 feet, to extend this interceptor to the common fence line between the John and Shirley Cochran and John and Leona Wells properties;

Whereas, the preferred route, as now expressed by John and Shirley Cochran, for the Candlewood Subdivision gravity sewer is down a natural drainage depression in the Cochran property, and such route would not interfere with future plat development of the Cochran property;

Whereas, there now exists an opportunity to gain additional length of interceptor at current unit prices contained in the agreement between the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee and Mainline Construction Company;

Whereas, the Grassy Branch Interceptor is a vital part of the wastewater system of Spring Hill and should be funded along with the wastewater treatment plant by whatever appropriate sources of funding are available; and

Whereas, it is anticipated by the Town engineer and Town staff that future prices for this category of work will be higher and the opportunity now exists to have this work done.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the construction of an additional 1,240 feet of the Grassy Branch Interceptor be added as a change order to the existing agreement between the Town of Spring Hill and Mainline Construction Company (see Resolution No. 97-1) for the sum of \$38,000 with funds to be drawn from sewer reserve capacity fees; and that a portion of the planned route of the secondary gravity sewer line, extending from Candlewood Subdivision through the Cochran property, be relocated to extend down the middle of a natural drainage basin to the lift station which is to be located at the fence line between the Cochran and Wells property.
