**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT  
WITH TRAFMARK, FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE,  
FOR STRIPING AND REFLECTORIZATION WORK  
ON KEDRON ROAD FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000  
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM CAPITOL PROJECTS FUNDS  
OF THE STREET DEPARTMENT**


**Whereas,** the lack of proper pavement marking and delineation has created dangerous driving conditions on Kedron Road,

**Whereas,** the governing Board has previously contracted with Highers Koonce and Associates, Consulting Engineers, to draft a specification for paving striping and reflectorization on Kedron Road in order to correct this dangerous conditions,

**Whereas,** as a consequence of proper public advertisement for bid requests, TrafMark, Franklin, Tennessee, responded with the lowest and best bid;


**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE,** that the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and enter into an agreement with TrafMark, Franklin, Tennessee, to perform paving striping and reflectorization on Kedron Road according to specifications prepared by Highers Koonce and Associates, Consulting Engineers, and according to a designation of specific work to be performed, per unit prices as shown in the TrafMark bid submittal, as the town staff in consultation with the town's engineer, may decide should be done; funds, not to exceed the sum of \$10,000, shall be drawn from the capital outlay fund of the streets budget
