
**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A

WHEREAS, the prevalence of drug use in today's society has brought about the need for a drug-use screening process; and


WHEREAS, the number of Spring Hill city employees has grown to a size that warrants the establishment of such a program; and
