
**A RESOLUTION REMOVING THE CITY OF SPRING HILL
FROM INCLUSION IN THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
COMMISSION'S NEW SUNDAY OPENING HOURS FOR
LIQUOR BY THE DRINK ESTABLISHMENTS**

Whereas, the Alcoholic Beverage Commission, with the approval of the State Legislature, has established a new rule allowing Liquor by the drink sales at 10:00 A. M. on Sunday mornings; and

Whereas, the new rule has a provision to allow local jurisdictions to opt out of the rule and maintain the Sunday opening time of 12:00 noon; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City will exercise its right under the new rule to opt out of the new Sunday opening hours and remain at 12:00 noon for the allowable opening time.


