

RESOLUTION 02-03

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3)
VEHICLES FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS AND UTILITY
DEPARTMENTS**

WHEREAS, the 2001-2002 Budget includes funds for the purchase of three (3) pickup trucks for the Public Works and Utility Departments; and

WHEREAS, the pressing need for such vehicles has been very clearly determined; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has concluded their bid process and has made the list of low bidders and vehicles available to local governments;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the purchase of three (3) pickup trucks is hereby authorized utilizing the State of Tennessee bid process and state bid prices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vehicles shall be purchased at the following state bid prices from the state authorized dealers;


- A. 2- 3/4 ton Chevrolet pickup trucks, \$20,051.73 each, total \$40,103.46, Bill Heard Chevrolet, Nashville, TN.
- B. 1- 1/2 ton Chevrolet pickup truck, \$17,193.53, Walker Chevrolet, Franklin, TN.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing vehicles be added to the open-end lease agreement currently in place with General Motors Acceptance Corporation.
