

**RESOLUTION 02-30**


**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONDUCT AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, ON APRIL 10, 2003, TO ELECT ONE (1) ALDERMAN FROM EACH OF THE FOUR (4) WARDS, PURSUANT TO THE ELECTION LAWS OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that:


The Maury County Election Commission is requested and authorized to conduct the regular municipal election for the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, on Thursday, April 10, 2003, for the purpose of electing one Alderman from each of the four (4) wards, all to be elected by registered voters from the city at large. Each newly elected Alderman to serve a term of four (4) years. The Commission is requested to publish notice of the election in both Maury and Williamson Counties.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to request the Maury County Election Commission to hold the aforesaid regular election on April 10, 2003, the cost of which shall be borne by the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee.


