A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) VEHICLE FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND FOUR (4) REPLACEMENT VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the 2003-2004 Budget includes funds for the purchase of one (1) pickup truck for the Water Treatment Plant, and four replacement vehicles for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the pressing need for such vehicles has been very clearly determined; and


WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has concluded their bid process and has made the list of low bidders and vehicles available to local governments;



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vehicles shall be purchased at the following state bid prices from the state authorized dealers;


- A. One 1/2 ton Chevrolet pickup truck at a price of, \$16,750.00 from Bill Heard Chevrolet, Nashville, TN.
- B. Four 2003 Chevrolet Impala police vehicles at a price of \$17,949.00 each from Wilson County Motors, Lebanon, TN
