

RESOLUTION 05-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAMSON COUNTY TO PROVIDE FIFTY (50%) PERCENT, UP TO FOUR MILLION (\$4,000,000) DOLLARS, OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW RECREATIONAL CENTER ON BUCKNER LANE AT DUPLEX ROAD


WHEREAS, the Williamson County Recreation Department is proposing to build and operate a new recreational facility in Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, the project is estimated to cost Eight Million (\$8,000,000) dollars to construct and equip; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County is asking the City of Spring Hill to provide Fifty (50%) percent of that cost; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City will provide 50% of the cost, up to Four Million (\$4,000,000) dollars, of the cost of construction for the new recreational facility.


