A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE UPDATED FIVE-YEAR STRATEGIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Three-Star Program was developed to meet the needs and challenges of the evolving economic environment in urban and rural communities and to partner with communities to create opportunities for sustained economic growth; and

WHEREAS, communities seeking certification as a Three-Star community must meet certain criteria, including the adoption of a five-year strategic economic development plan; and

WHEREAS, in achieving the mission of the Three-Star Program, the Department of Economic and Community Development commits to assist communities in developing and implementing a strategic economic plan; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, meeting in regular session in Spring Hill, Tennessee, that:

SECTION 1. The legislative body of the City of Spring Hill agrees to adhere to the updated five-year strategic economic development plan, which was originally adopted by Williamson County.

SECTION 2. The strategic economic development plan includes Williamson County's economic goals in promoting economic growth, a plan to accomplish those goals and a projected timeline in achieving those goals.


