

RESOLUTION 06-02

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF SPRING HILL
EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO PROVIDE RETIREES
WITH CONTINUING HEALTH AND DENTAL INSURANCE
COVERAGE**

WHEREAS, establishing this program is an effort to provide for the continued well-being of City employees after their retirement from City employment; and

WHEREAS, the City has the capability to continue to provide retired employees and their families with adequate health and dental insurance coverage; and

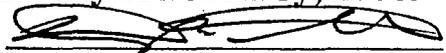
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the City Retirement System is hereby amended to include the continuation of existing health and dental insurance coverage upon their retirement from City employment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following qualifying requirements shall be met at the time of retirement;

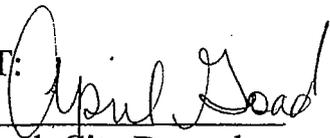
An employee must be at least sixty-five (65) years of age and have at least five (5) years vested in the City retirement system; or

An employee must be at least fifty-five (55) years of age and have at least twenty-five (25) years of creditable employment with the City, as described under the existing retirement criteria.

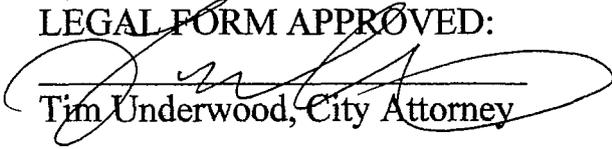
