**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE

**WHEREAS**, there is a critical need for the installation of roadway guardrails along Miles Johnson Parkway; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Spring Hill has advertised for proposals for the installation of guardrails along Miles Johnson Parkway, from licensed, qualified contractors by sealed bid, on or before 10:30 a.m., December 5, 2008; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee that an expenditure of approximately \$20,219.60 is hereby authorized for the installation roadway guardrails along Miles Johnson Parkway from Williamson County Fence and Guardrail, Inc., as recommended by staff after review of all bids.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the expenditure be drawn from General Fund.

**Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, this 15th day of December, 2008.**





Miles Johnson Parkway is located between Hwy 31 (SR 6) and Old Kedron Road located in the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee. Interested, licensed and qualified contractors shall submit sealed bids in the format specified in the Request for Quotations no later than **10:30 am local time (CST) December 5, 2008** at which time sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for a period of 90 days.
